



Note on RAG Rating Score

Student Doctor evaluate their experience at the end of each rotation/sub-rotation against core statements using a four-point, Likert scale from 'Strongly Disagree' to 'Strongly Agree'. Individual responses are transformed to a bipolar score (-2 to +2) and an average for each statement is subsequently calculated. RED, AMBER, GREEN (RAG) colour coding is then applied using the thresholds below to identify where action is required.

RAG Colour	Score	Action
RED	Score less than zero	Significant improvement needed
AMBER	Score between 0-0.55	Improvements needed within three months
NO FLAG	Score between 0.56-1.55	Satisfactory
GREEN	Scores above 1.55	Excellent
